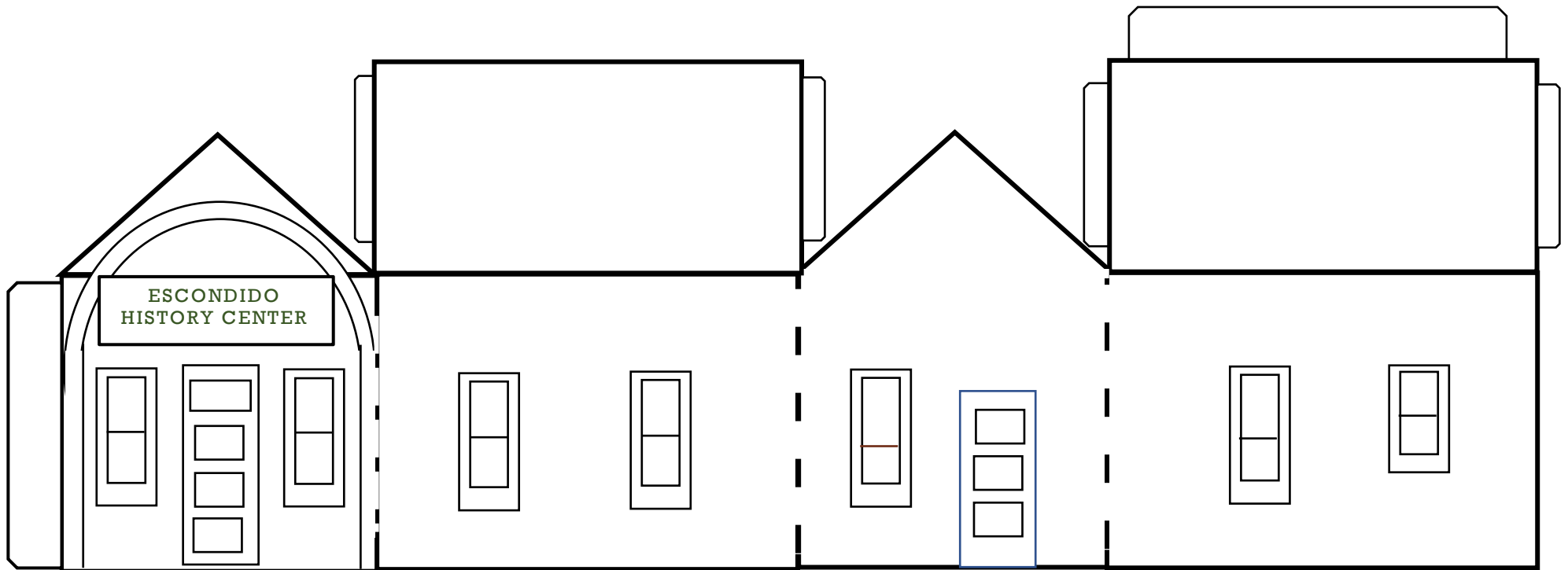


**MAKE YOUR OWN
ESCONDIDO HISTORY CENTER
OFFICE & RESEARCH CENTER**

The Escondido Office and Research Center is located at the Escondido History Center in Grape Day Park. The building was Escondido's first library. It was built on Grand Avenue at Hickory in 1894 but it was moved to its current site in 1971. Today, you will find a few artifacts on display there and lots of books and papers related to Escondido's history, as well as the History Center staff members.



Directions for putting together your own historic building:

1. Color the building. It's now yellow and brown but you can make it any colors you want!
2. Cut out along all outside lines.
3. Fold along the dotted lines to create the building's corners, where the rectangular roof sections meet the walls, and fold at each tab.
4. Glue or tape the tabs inside the building.
5. You're finished! Enjoy your very own replica of Escondido's first library!
